Call for Proposals for Continuing Education (CE) Courses

Due March 15, 2019

Proposals for Continuing Education are invited and may include, but are not limited, to the following topics: Environmental Economic Motivators, Radon Risk Communication, Radon Risk Assessment, Radon Prevention in Existing and New Construction, Marketing and Business Approaches for the Radon Professional, and Practical Approaches to Mitigation and Measurement Techniques.

Pre-Symposium CE Courses (2,4 or 8 hours) – 3 to 4 courses are anticipated to be held on Sunday, September 8, 2019. Proposals for these courses should be 250 words or less and:

1) List the requested amount of time; 2) State the primary target audience for the course; 3) Clearly reflect the course's title, learning objectives, and presenters; 4) List the name and contact information of the individual submitting the proposal; 5) List current/pending course approvals; and 6) be submitted electronically in Word (.doc) format to nicole@aarst.org with "**Pre-Symposium Course Proposal**" listed in the message subject line.

Submit suggested pricing for your course. *Note that course instructors receive 75% of the course fee and do not have to pay for room or AV set up & screen. You must provide your material and a laptop. AARST has set the 8 hour course price at 240.00

Your submission will be acknowledged, upon receipt, and forwarded on to the Planning Committee for consideration. Late submissions will be considered at the discretion of the Planning Committee Chair but will not be accepted after May 1, 2019.
